In addition to this, our roofs can cut down heating costs, achieving 0.15 W/M2K u value on a standard installation, with the use of insulated plasterboard a value of 0.10 W/M2K is achievable.

- Frame constructed from C24 Structural Timber
- Attached are Structural Insulated Panels (SIPS)
- SIPS are combined of OSB Board and Insulation
- Plasterboard can be fixed directly to SIPS
- No need for Battening
- No Aluminium so Cold Bridging is avoided
- All in all meaning less time on site!

Warm Roof Pro is plastered internally and externally finished with stylish Tapco slate plastic tiles.

These come in a range of colours, including; Chestnut Brown, Stone Black, Pewter Grey, Brick Red, Plum and Red Rock.



When the ceiling is painted white, a lot of light is achieved. This can be enhanced with pelmet or surfboard down lighting.

Natural lighting and ventilation (if required), can be achieved by installation of **Velux Windows**, which we will be happy to supply.

Warm Roof Pro have sourced a professional partner, ASW Consultants Ltd, who have access to Surveyors Nationwide and can undertake the Building Regulation Application process on your behalf from commencement to completion of your project to ensure that all functional requirements are met.

To obtain ASW Consultants Ltd's approval, we were required to load 60kg per m² (for European Standards) and 70kg per m² (for British building standards). This weight was to remain in situ for one week, followed by two days at 100kg per m². We felt this was inadequate for the strength of **Warm Roof Pro**, so we immediately loaded it to 75kg per m² for one week and upped this weight to 108kg per m² for an additional two days. This roof was 6m x 6m and free standing with only 3mm of spread.

All legal required documentation will be provided upon satisfactory completion of your project. ASW Consultant Ltd can also provide a one stop shop for all associated project design needs such as thermal calculations and structural designs.
